WHAT DOES AMERICAN FINANCE L.L.C. DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect can include:

- Social Security number and income.
- Account balances and payment history.
- Credit history, credit scores, and phone numbers.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons American Finance chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does American Finance protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does American Finance collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- Open an account;
- Pay your bills or provide account information;
- Apply for financing or give us your contact information;
- Provide income information or provide employment information;
- Provide your residence or phone information.

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness;
- affiliates from using your information to market to you;
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you.

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

Non-affiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

Other Important Information

For California residents: We will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, including, for example, with your consent or to service your account.

Nevada Residents: This notice is provided to you pursuant to state law. You may be placed on our internal Do Not Call List by following the directions in the "To limit our sharing" section above.
